VALUES OF TEACHING GEOGRAPHY

We find that knowledge of geography is important in understanding and acquiring the knowledge of various social sciences. Such a knowledge can be used for the economic progress of a country or a region. We flourish in the world only if we have economic prosperity.

Social Values

A knowledge of geography helps a student in developing a proper social outlook which develops a feeling of brotherhood for the nationals of other countries & makes a student broadminded. Ultimately he no more remains self-centred and he develops a feeling of world citizenship. Thus a knowledge of geography has a social prominence. Moreover geography lays the emphasis of rural/urban/regional planning and minimises the regional differentiation.

Values for earning a livelihood

We spend a major part of our life in earning our livelihood & the knowledge of geography can be helpful to us to utilize our leisure twice in a beneficial way. It ensures us to identify, utilise, conserve and create resources for human welfare.

• Cultural values

Geography develop a feeling of patriotism, love for nature and capacity to understand & appreciate the natural beauty, physical forces and such other things, imbibe the ideals of world citizenship, universal brotherhood, co-operation and sympathetic outlook for others, assess the cultural values in the light of values of land and the man and appreciate the adjustment of human life according to the geographical circumstances.

• Intellectual Values

Geography develops the power of observation, the power of thinking, reasoning, memory & power of imagination, ability to draw conclusion, to generalise and develop scientific attitude and also to develop the ability to draw valid conclusion & interdependent thinking in the skills of reading map & globes, drawing & measuring skills and also in using & manipulating geographical instruments.
