2) Other measures that take into account the importance of female participation and equality include: the Gender Parity Index on the Gender-related Development Index (GDI). GDI is a way in which the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) measures the inequality between genders within a country.

A more qualitative form of assessing women's empowerment is to identify constraints to action. This allows for the identification of power relations between genders.
